NOMINATION FOR COUNCIL PRESIDENT:

NOMINATION FOR COUNCIL VICE PRESIDENT:

Mayor Rape asked for nominations for Vice President. Jim Hulings nominated Greg Such for Council Vice President. The Harmony Borough Council unanimously approved Greg Such for Council Vice President.

NOMINATION FOR PRO-TEM:

Mayor Rape asked for nominations for Pro-Tem. Jim Hulings nominated Frank Luek for Council Pro-Tem. The Harmony Borough Council unanimously approved Frank Luek for Council Pro-Tem.

Reorganization Meeting AGENDA

1. The 2013 President Calls meeting to Order.
2. Pledge of Allegiance.
3. The newly elected Mayor provides "Certificate of Election" and turns in "Affidavit of Residency" over to the Borough Secretary.

The Mayor is sworn in by the Borough Secretary (who is a Notary Public).

Mayor presides over meeting until officers are elected.

4. Newly Elected Council members present "Certificate of Election" and turn in "Affidavits of Residency" to the Borough Secretary.

Mayor swears in:

Greg Such
Donald Sims
Jarod Stewart

All Newly elected members must be seated at this time.

5. The Mayor asks for nominations for **President**. (Nominations do not require a second).

After the Mayor closes the nominations, a voice vote is taken naming each person in the order they were nominated and asking for a yes vote.

If more than two people are nominated, then the nominee with the lowest number of votes is dropped from the list.

A new vote is taken on the remaining nominees.

The process is repeated until one person has received a majority number of Council votes.

6. The Mayor asks for nominations for **Vice - President**. - Same process as for president.
7. The Mayor asks for nominations for **President Pro-Tem**. - Same process as for president.
8. Meeting is turned over to the 2014 - 2015 President
9. **Adjourn**

NOTE: The Mayor is not eligible to vote or break ties in the election of officers.
