

ORDINANCE NO: 417

**THE BOROUGH OF HARMONY**

BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE TO PROMOTE AND PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE BOROUGH OF HARMONY, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING PARKING ON WOOD STREET.

**WHEREAS**, in order to promote and protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Harmony, Butler County, Pennsylvania (the "Borough"), the Borough has determined it necessary to regulate the parking of vehicles on Wood Street.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Harmony, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of same as follows:

SECTION I. No Parking.

That hereafter it shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle or other vehicles:

On the East Side of Wood Street south of Mercer Street in the areas from:

- The southeast corner of Wood Street and Mercer Street to 40 feet from the southeast corner
- 102 feet from the southeast corner of Wood Street and Mercer Street to 118 feet from the southeast corner.

On the West Side of Wood Street south of Mercer Street in the area from:

- The southwest corner of Wood Street and Mercer Street to 150 feet from the southwest corner

SECTION 2. Signage.

The erection and maintenance of all necessary signage is hereby authorized. Said signage shall be placed so as to properly notify all vehicular traffic of the imposed regulations.

SECTION 3. Enforcement.

It shall be the duty of the police officers having jurisdiction within the Borough to institute the prosecution of all persons violating Section 1 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Penalty.

Whoever violates Section 1 of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00).

SECTION 5. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances not in accord with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.
