ORDINANCE NO. 421

BOROUGH OF HARMONY BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HARMONY, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 27 OF THE HARMONY BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADD PROVISIONS RELATING TO PRIMITIVE STRUCTURES IN A C-2 ZONING DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, in order to promote and protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Harmony, Butler County, Pennsylvania, the Borough Council has determined it necessary to prohibit obstructions to sidewalks within the Borough.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Harmony as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 27-105 of the Harmony Borough Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to add the following definition:

"PRIMITIVE STRUCTURE: Anything constructed or erected on the ground or attached to the ground including, but not limited to buildings, sheds, and other similar items that may, or may not, have utilities and are primarily used for the display of handmade, primitive, historical, and/or cultural items and artifacts."

SECTION 2. Chapter 27-111(A) of the Harmony Borough Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to add the following as a permitted principle use in a C-2 Zoning District:

"20. Primitive Structure"

SECTION 3. Chapter 27-111(D)(5) of the Harmony Borough Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to add the following:

"c. Primitive Structures 15 feet"

SECTION 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
