ORDINANCE NO. 374

AN ORDINANCE TO PROMOTE AND PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE BOROUGH OF HARMONY, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND FOR THE PURPOSE PROHIBITING THE FEEDING OF CERTAIN WATERFOWL WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF HARMONY, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, in order to promote and protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Harmony, Butler County, Pennsylvania (the "Borough"), the Borough has determined that it is necessary to provide certain regulations and requirements providing for the prohibition of feeding certain waterfowl within the Borough.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Harmony, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of same as follows:

SECTION 1. Addition of Regulations Prohibiting the Feeding of Waterfowl.

Chapter 2, Part I "Animals Running at Large", of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Harmony is hereby amended to also include Sections 2-101(5) and 2-102(5), as follows:

"SECTION 2-101 Definitions.

5. Waterfowl is defined as the giant race of Canada Goose and Mallard duck.

SECTION 2-102 Prohibitions.

...


5. Feeding of Waterfowl. No person shall feed, cause or permit to be fed or provide food for ducks, geese and/or waterfowl within Harmony Borough."

SECTION 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances not in accord with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.
