ORDINANCE NO. 384

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE RENAMING OF A STREET KNOWN AS "KASING WAY" TO "HARMONY WAY" IN HARMONY BOROUGH; PROVIDING FOR PLACEMENT OF STREET SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE OFFICIAL BOROUGH STREET MAP AND THE BOROUGH ZONING MAP; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Harmony Borough Council deems that the renaming the street known as "Kasing Way" to "Harmony Way" is in the best interests of the Borough of Harmony, Butler County, Pennsylvania (the "Borough").

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Harmony, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of same as follows:
