**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HARMONY, BUTLER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 27 OF
THE HARMONY BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES TO DELETE AND
REMOVE CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE.**

WHEREAS, in order to promote and protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Harmony, Butler County, Pennsylvania, the Borough Council has determined it necessary to prohibit obstructions to sidewalks within the Borough.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Harmony as follows:

The following sections of the Harmony Borough Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 27 of the Harmony Borough Code of Ordinances, are hereby deleted and removed:

- Chapter 27 Section 115(B)(5) – Noise
- Chapter 27 Section 115(B)(6) – Odors
- Chapter 27 Section 115(B)(7) – Air Pollution
- Chapter 27 Section 115(B)(8) – Glare
- Chapter 27 Section 115(B)(9) – Water Pollution
- Chapter 27 Section 115(B)(10) – Storage of Solid Waste, Trash and Garbage

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
