Supervisor's Report: Wade Ion obtained a price of \$800 from the Stump Man to trim 9 trees (at the playground, the square, and at McFarland's)

He also reported that after East New Castle street was paved, some of the yards need tapered and need topsoil.

Frank Luck made a motion to trim the trees for \$800. Gary Habsburg seconded the motion. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Public Safety: Discussed borrowing Cranberry Township's line painter to paint the crosswalks.

Wade Ion is going to move the street light at Knauf's Feed Mill.

Request for Leah LeFebvre: To block off Center Street for a block party on August 23 from Ed Knaufs to the dead end. Gary recommended not totally blocking the street in case of an emergency. Possibly borrowing the Borough's orange cones.

Electronic Recycling: Cost for Harmony Borough is \$287.50. Dave Szakelyhidi made a motion to participate. Gary Habsburg seconded the motion. Discussion concerning how many of Harmony Borough residents participate. Motion carried.

Public Safety:

Mayor Rape reported that the Police want to get the walking patrol going.
