AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HARMONY, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 397 TO REVISE SECTIONS THREE AND FIVE, OPEN BURNING OF LEAVES, BRUSH, CLEAN WOOD AND OTHER VEGETATIVE DEBRIS

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Borough Council of the

Borough of Harmony as follows:

Section Three of Ordinance No. 397 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 3.3 of Ordinance No. 397 is hereby added:

Section 3.3 Recreational Burning. A recreational fire is defined as an outdoor fire, burning materials other than rubbish, having a total fuel area of 3 feet or less in diameter and 2 feet or less in height for pleasure, religious, ceremonial, cooking warmth or similar purposes. Recreational fires must be 10 feet or more from the nearest property line.

Section Five of Ordinance No. 397 is hereby deleted and replaced with the following: Section 1.

SECTION 5. OPEN BURNING OF LEAVES, BRUSH, WOOD AND OTHER VEGETATIVE DEBRIS

5.0 Open burning of leaves, weeds, brush, stumps, wood, trees, and other vegetative debris is prohibited.

Section 2.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
