ORDINANCE NO. 394

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HARMONY, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING AND ESTABLISHING A POLICE SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF ZELIENOPLE TO PROVIDE POLICE SERVICE THROUGHOUT THE BOROUGH OF HARMONY.

WHEREAS, the Harmony Borough Council is vested with the responsibility for protecting the public health, safety and welfare under provisions of the Borough Council Code; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Harmony and the Borough of Zelienople desires to enter into an Agreement whereby the Borough of Zelienople will provide police service throughout the Borough of Harmony; and

WHEREAS, the respective municipalities have agreed between themselves as to the implementation of the said police service; and

WHEREAS, the respective municipalities have acted and intend to act pursuant to the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Law, 53 Pa.C.S. Section 2302, et seq., providing for intergovernmental cooperation; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement has been submitted to the governing bodies of the respective municipalities prior to the adoption of an ordinance encompassing the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACED AND ORDAINED by the Harmony Borough Council, as follows:

SECTION 1: The agreement for police service between the Harmony Borough and the Borough of Zelienople dated January 1, 2012 and attached hereto is approved in its entirety.

SECTION 2: The term of this Agreement shall commence as of the 1st day of January, 2012 and shall continue until the 31st day of December 2019.

SECTION 3: The Borough of Zelienople Police Department shall, under this agreement and ordinance, have full and complete police authority within the jurisdictional limits of Harmony Borough under the terms of the intergovernmental police service agreement and this ordinance.

SECTION 4: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Harmony Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately or as soon as legally permissible.

SECTION 7: It is declared that the adoption of this Ordinance and the execution, acknowledgement and delivery of the documents are necessary for the protection, benefit and preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the general public of the Harmony Borough.

SECTION 8: This Ordinance may be changed by resolution to extend or add a new police service agreement.
