THE BOROUGH OF HARMONY

BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE TO PROMOTE AND PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE BOROUGH OF HARMONY, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING PARKING ON GERMAN STREET DURING CONSTRUCTION.

WHEREAS, in order to promote and protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Harmony, Butler County, Pennsylvania (the "Borough"), the Borough has determined it necessary to regulate the parking of vehicles on German Street so as to eliminate traffic congestion or other hazardous conditions during construction;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Harmony, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of same as follows:

SECTION 1. No Parking.

That hereafter it shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle or other vehicle, as defined by the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S. § 102, on either side of German Street from Main Street to Robinson Industries Main Parking Lot, during the period time wherein roadway construction on German street is taking place.

SECTION 2. Enforcement.

When any law enforcement officer shall find a vehicle in violation of this Ordinance, he is authorized to issue a citation and/or to remove or to have removed by an authorized towing service any vehicle abandoned or parked in violation of this Ordinance. The registered owner of any such vehicle shall be notified of the fact of the

removal and of the place to which said vehicle has been towed, where he or she may obtain the same upon payment of any and all towing and storage charges. The payment of towing and storage charges authorized by this provision shall not operate to relieve the owner or operator of any vehicle from liability for any fine or penalty for violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3.

The presence of any vehicle on any street when abandoned or parked in violation of this ordinance is prima facie evidence that the registered owner of the vehicle committed or authorized the commission of the violation.

SECTION 4.

Borough Council from time to time shall be authorized by Resolution to amend Section 1 of this Ordinance to include other areas and/or streets located within the Borough of Harmony in order to eliminate traffic congestion or other hazardous conditions.

SECTION 4. Signage.

The erection and maintenance of all necessary signage is hereby authorized. Said signage shall be placed so as to properly notify all vehicular traffic of the imposed regulations.

SECTION 5. Penalty.

Whoever violates Section 1 of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00).

SECTION 6. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances not in accord with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.
