RESOLUTION NO. 2025-3-4**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE HARMONY BOROUGH, BUTLER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO ENTER INTO
AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT TO
ESTABLISH AND PROVIDE FUNDING FOR AN ADMINISTRATOR
POSITION EMPLOYED BY THE SOUTHWESTERN BUTLER COUNCIL
OF GOVERNMENTS**

WHEREAS, the Harmony Borough, Butler County, is a duly organized Borough under the Pennsylvania Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S. § 101, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Law, 53 Pa. Cons. Stat. §§ 2301-15, governs intergovernmental cooperation within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and permits Pennsylvania local governments to enter into agreements with one another as may be deemed appropriate for the joint cooperation in the exercise of their respective governmental functions; and

WHEREAS, the Boroughs of Harmony and Zelienople and the Townships of Jackson and Lancaster in Butler County, Pennsylvania, (“Member Municipalities”) have formed and participate in a Council of Governments, known as the Southwestern Butler Council of Governments (“SWBCOG”); and

WHEREAS, the Harmony Borough desires to enter into an intergovernmental with the Member Municipalities, the Harmony Fire District, and the Southwest Butler Stormwater Authority for the purposes of establishing and funding an administrator position to be employed by the SWBCOG.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Harmony Borough, Butler County, that Harmony Borough, Butler County, is authorized to enter into that Intergovernmental Cooperation & Establishment Agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”.

RESOLVED and **ADOPTED** this 4th day of March, 2025, by the Council of Harmony Borough in lawful session duly assembled. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

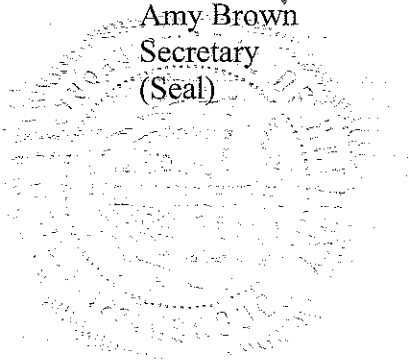
