**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF HARMONY,  
BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,  
ESTABLISHING A PERMIT FEE FOR STREET OPENINGS**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Harmony, Butler County, Pennsylvania (the "Borough"), is a duly organized municipality with the authority to regulate the use of its public streets, roads, alleys, and rights-of-way within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Harmony has determined that it is necessary and appropriate to charge a permit fee for street openings to defray the administrative and inspection costs associated with the review, issuance, and oversight of street opening permits; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has the authority under the Borough Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, 8 Pa. C.S. § 101 et seq., and other applicable law, to establish reasonable fees for permits issued by the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has reviewed the costs associated with processing street opening permit applications and determined that a fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per opening is reasonable and appropriate;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Harmony, Butler County, Pennsylvania, as follows:**

**Section 1. Street Opening Permit Fee Established.** Effective upon adoption of this Resolution, a permit fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) shall be charged for each street opening within the public streets, roads, alleys, or rights-of-way of the Borough of Harmony. No street opening permit shall be issued until the applicable fee has been paid in full.

**Section 2. Permit Required.** No person, firm, corporation, or other entity shall open, excavate, cut, or in any manner disturb the surface of any public street, road, alley, or right-of-way within the Borough of Harmony without first obtaining a street opening permit from the Borough and paying the fee established herein.

**Section 3. Fee Review.** The Borough Council may, from time to time, review and adjust the permit fee established herein by subsequent resolution to reflect changes in administrative costs or other relevant factors.

**Section 4. Repealer.** All prior resolutions, ordinances, or parts thereof inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
