

ORDINANCE NO. 448

**AN ORDINANCE OF HARMONY BOROUGH, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
REGULATING THE DESIGNATED TRUCK ROUTE WITHIN HARMONY BOROUGH.**

WHEREAS, Borough Council of the Borough of Harmony have previously adopted Chapter 15, Part 4, Section 401 of the Harmony Borough Code of Ordinances relating to the designated truck route within the Borough;

WHEREAS, the Borough Council is now cognizant of the fact that the provisions relating to the truck route must be amended for the best interest of or benefit to the Borough of Harmony;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Harmony that Chapter 15, Part 4, Section 410 of the Borough of Harmony Code of Ordinances is hereby rescinded and replaced with the following provisions;

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of Harmony Borough, Butler County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

Section 1.

Chapter 15, Part 4, Section 410 of the Borough of Harmony Code of Ordinances is hereby rescinded and replaced with the following:

SECTION 15-401 Designated Route

That for the protection of certain streets in the Borough of Harmony and for the safety of the traveling public, vehicles above the weight limits set by the Borough of Harmony in Chapter 15, Part 3, must follow the established truck routes when traveling through the Borough of Harmony, The truck routes are established as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Route 68 and Main Street, and proceeding to the intersection of Main Street and German Street; thence proceeding East on German Street to the Borough boundary also Spring Street from German Street to Mercer Street and then West on Mercer Street. At the West end of Mercer Street the truck route proceeds South on Water Street. Robinson Drive from the West side of Main Street West to the B&O Railroad. Old Mercer Road from the Borough boundary to the intersection of Evergreen Mill Road. All of Evergreen Mill Road within the Borough boundaries as shown on the official zoning map #223 of the Borough of Harmony.

Section 2. Severability.

If any provision is held invalid, remaining provisions shall remain in effect.

Section 3. Repealer.

All inconsistent ordinances or parts thereof are repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
